Our RE Programme is structured for primary-school children and is not suitable for secondary school children. Children should undertake all the Sacraments of Initiation (beginning with Baptism and concluding with Confirmation) at the parish in which they live. If you live outside the Parish of Our Lady & St Therese, Essendon you should seek Religious Education at your parish.

## **PROGRAMME DETAILS**

- Three x one hour sessions are held on Sundays at 9.30am in PACE function room
- Children must attend all sessions to be eligible to receive the Sacrament and parents will be required to sign their child in to each session using a QR code
- At least one parent/guardian to attend with student
- Siblings and unenrolled children are not permitted to stay

## **FAITH NIGHTS**

Faith nights are an opportunity for candidates and parents to learn more about the Sacrament and engage in some guided discussion. Candidate needs to attend with at least one parent. No siblings may attend.

## **CANDIDATE MASS**

Candidates are asked to attend a Mass where they are introduced to the congregation and where the congregation commits to supporting them in their faith journey. Candidates can attend any parish Mass on the nominated weekend.

## **SACRAMENT MASS**

Our RE students celebrate Sacrament Masses alongside the St Therese's parish school children.

The First Reconciliation Service and the Confirmation Masses are stand-alone services. First Eucharist Sacrament Masses are celebrated at our usual weekend Masses.

## **DRESS CODE**

For Sacrament Masses children are asked to dress in smart casual clothing with their Sacramental stole.

There is no requirement for girls to wear white dresses for First Eucharist Masses.

## **REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS**

### **Minimum school year level requirements**

First Reconciliation: Student must be in Year 3 or above

First Eucharist: Student must be in Year 4 or above

Confirmation: Student must be in Year 6 or above

### **The Parish requires the following paperwork:**

- Baptism certificate if registering for Reconciliation
- Reconciliation certificate if registering for Eucharist
- Eucharist certificate if registering for Confirmation

## **COSTS**

## **SACRAMENTAL STOLE**

A Sacramental stole is provided to each child at the commencement of their first RE programme with the parish. Their stole should be retained between Sacraments.
